- Eckard Road has been marked for repairs. Stephenson Equipment has a pavement recycler for rent at a cost of \$10,937.50 for two weeks. This machine will mill the sections of Eckard Road that need to be repaired. The supervisors agreed this would be a good solution for cost effective repairs.
